

## PRODUCT SAFETY INFORMATION



Read the instruction manual carefully before using the microwave.

Ensure that you understand all the safety precautions and warnings provided in the manual.

Only use the microwave when the truck is parked or stationary.

Do not use the microwave while the vehicle is in motion.

Ensure that the microwave is properly installed and secured to prevent it from moving or falling during transit.

Check the mounting brackets regularly to ensure they are secure.

Use only microwave-safe dishes and containers.

Do not use metal containers or utensils as they can cause sparks and damage to the microwave.

## RISK OF ELECTRIC SHOCK

## **Important Install Information**



Install of this product should be carried out by a **qualified auto-electrician** or other trained engineer, familiar with the vehicle manufacturers body builder guidelines.



You may need specialist equipment or items to connect this product to your vehicle. We urge you to check you have everything required before fitting.



Power for this product must be taken from a **fused**, **40amp 24 volt supply**. This should be done so in line with the vehicle OEM's bodybuilder electrical connection guidelines



Ensure the correct PPE is worn and the vehicle is totally islolated from all electrical power before working on it. We recommend batteries are disconnected.



Never touch, or leave bare / stripped wires due to the risk of electrical shock. The capacitors inside the microwave will store power even when switched off or disconnected.



Never try to connect any other electrical equipment to this appliance or it's built in power supply. This is not safe to do so and will void the products warranty.
